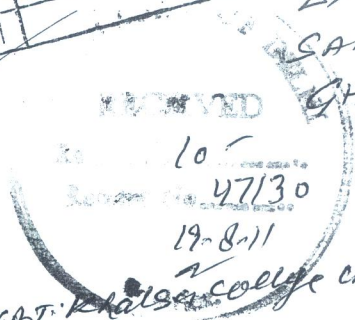

This has reference to your application dated 18.08.2011, received at the college office on 23 August, seeking information under RTI Act 2005.

This is to inform you that Mr. Akhilesh Kumar a visually challenged applicant was offered appointed as Assistant Professor in English against a substantive post with exemption from the NET subject to passing NET or completing M. Phil within two years. The appointment and relaxation from having cleared the NET or completing M.Phil as the essential qualification was subject to approval of the University of Delhi and University Grants Commission. The University Grants Commission conveyed approval for exemption from NET in respect of Mr. Akhilesh Kumar. However the UGC withdrew the approval of relaxation from NET in respect of Mr. Akhilesh Kumar.
