This has reference to your application dated 19 August 2010 seeking information under RTI Act 2005 regarding the fee of (M.Com.) Final Year at the College.

In the light of the fact that the College is developing and improving the infrastructure, the Governing Body of the College was forced to increase the fee due to the following reasons.

1. Most of the Colleges mentioned in your application had obtained funds from the UGC and the University under OBC expansion, SGTB Khalsa College did not receive any such funds for improving the infrastructure in the College.
2. The College recently has completed the auditorium worth almost eight crores which was mainly funded by the parent's body i.e. Delhi Sikh Gurdwara Management Committee and the College had to fund it partially.
3. The College has developed the ultramodern laboratories with latest equipment and Chemicals in all the science labs.
4. The College has bought many new computers and provided access to University Network in the various labs and College library.
5. The College last year added an air-conditioned space in the reading room with internet facilities in the library for 200 students and teachers.
6. All the College passages and roads have been improved and the entire campus has been made physically disabled friendly. This has greatly benefited the students with physical disabilities for getting to the building and through the escalator in the Science Block.
7. All the major passages have been provided with tec-tiles and guiding - tiles for the blind students.
8. The entire ground floor and many labs on the upper floors along with the College library have been air-conditioned for comfortable environment for the students and teachers.
9. A new state of the art Guru Arjan Dev Seminar Hall has been added with modern acoustics, lighting and other electronic and electrical accessories.


