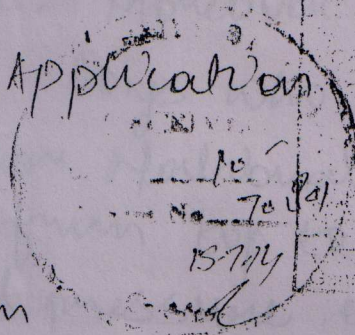

According to the list displayed on your college notice board 4 boys are being selected on the basis of trials for Basketball. I wish to inform you that out of them 3 boys are those who haven't represent even their national teams in any National championship.

As per the list displayed HARSH BHATIA has got 8 marks in certificates and 49 marks in sports trial and this thing seems to be so unrealistic, a boy who has only 8 marks in certificates was good enough to secure 49 marks in his trial performance. The trials which seemed to be so transparent on the day of test were not the same with respect to the results you have declared. I want information regarding the selection criteria of the trial in

of from your side as this is not just about a single day but it's keeping the future of many more students seeking admissions through sports at stake. Moreover I wish to inform you that there were boys who have represented their states in senior National Championships but were neglected from top to bottom just for the sake of forced pressure of giving admissions to students who were not deserving for so. I want you to give me complete information regarding this as soon as possible.

As per Clause-II para 2 of the above mentioned circular, a Sports Admission Committee is formed consisting of:

- Chairperson : Principal
- Convener: Teacher in-charge Dept. of Physical Education
- Physical Education teacher(s) as member(s)
- One Expert nominated by college out of the confidential list given by Delhi University Sports Council
- Only one faculty member nominated by the Staff Council
- One regular bon-fide sports-student representative (M/W for assistance)
- One Delhi University Sports Council representative/nominee
- One Vice Chancellor nominee (as observer)

A maximum of 50 marks for Sports Trials includes skill test, game performance test, game specific fitness, fundamentals of the game / sport etc. is awarded by the technical staff from the above. A maximum of 50 marks is awarded for the past participation and performance of the candidate, in accordance with the criteria laid down by the University of Delhi vide the criteria quoted above.

What seems to be "deserving" or not to the appellate is a matter of his personal prejudices and has nothing to do with the objective criteria followed by the College.

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


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
