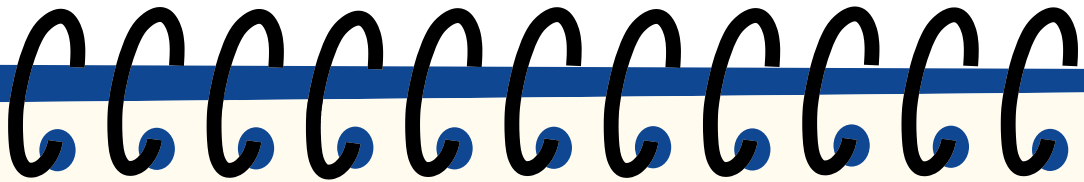

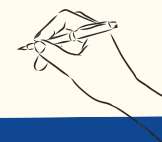

ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

Certificate Course:

- Candidate should have passed 10+2 examination or any other equivalent system. Marks of best four (10+2) including English/Hindi will be considered for merit. An aggregate of at least 45% marks are required to apply for admission.
- Applicants are advised to submit all the information carefully.
- The Merit Lists does not guarantee admission to any foreign language course. It is subject to verification of marks and original documents.

Diploma Courses:

- For admission in Diploma courses (German/French/Spanish) it is mandatory to have Certificate in the respective language i.e. successful completion of Certificate in German/French/Spanish offered by University of Delhi.

ADMISSION PROCEDURE

- Online Registration Forms and details are available on the college website.

- One-time registration fee of INR 210/- is payable for Registration (non-refundable).
- On-the-spot admission will be offered, depending on the availability of seats.
- Once selected, candidates must complete the online fee payment within three days. Failure to do so will result in cancellation of the admission offer.
- An amount of INR 1000/- will be deducted if admission is cancelled within 7 days of fee payment. No refund will be allowed after that.

LAST DATE OF ADMISSION

All admissions will be finalized by 1st August. Extensions may be considered only if seats remain vacant.

TIMINGS
