Realizing the gravity of the mistake, the representation from the students was forwarded to the University for Sympathetic Consideration and evaluation of the scripts according to the question paper attempted by them. *This is also to inform that the scripts were sent to University in a separate packet.*

College authorities took the matter at appropriate level with the University authorities and they were promised sympathetic consideration of the request of the students.

Rest of the matter rests with the University, a solution can only be found at University level.
