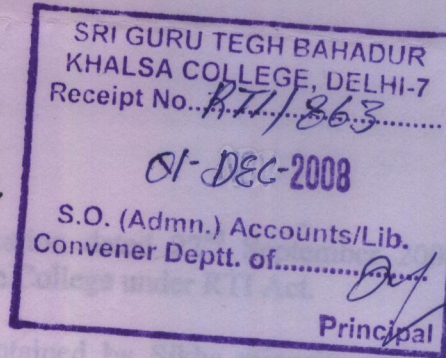

Dear Sir,

I have recieved your letter No. RTI/2589
dt. 5.11.2008 (copy enclosed) referring to Article 30(1)
of the Constitution of India which empowers you
to admit upto 50% student for minority category.

The information is wrong and misleading on
two counts.

- i) your College has not been granted Any minority
status and writ is pending before Honorable
High Court of Delhi. so, using minority quota is
illegal.
- ii) Article 30(1) of the Constitution of India does
not mention, as stated by P.I.O. (Copy enclosed.)

It is also important that, "when writ is pending
in the Honorable High Court of Delhi, using minority
status amounts to Contempt of Court."
Please take necessary action as per R.T.I. Rules
against P.I.O.



THE CONSTITUTION OF INDIA

Article 30

Right of minorities to establish and administer educational institutions.- (1) All minorities, whether based on religion or language, shall have the right to establish and administer educational institutions of their choice.

_20[(1A) In making any law providing for the compulsory acquisition of any property of any educational institution established and administered by a minority, referred to in clause (1), the State shall ensure that the amount fixed by or determined under such law for the acquisition of such property is such as would not restrict or abrogate the right guaranteed under that clause.]

(2) The State shall not, in granting aid to educational institutions, discriminate against any educational institution on the ground that it is under the management of a minority, whether based on religion or language.
